A GLANCE AT OUR DAILY REGIMAN!!!!

- 1. Bus-students** should not attend school if they are showing any signs of being ill. Disposable masks will be mandatory to wear on the bus. Students will be provided a mask, but they can also bring their own mask if they choose. EA's will ride the bus daily and will be conducting a survey/questionnaire with each child in addition to taking temperatures. Children in Nursery to Grade One should have a parent or guardian escort them to the bus to help answer the questions. ****Students will keep their mask on until they reach their classroom.**
- 2. Arrival at School-**All students will enter the school at the specified location where they will wash their hands or use sanitizer. They will proceed directly to their classroom. **Staff & students must wear a mask in common areas of the school. We have allowed for social distancing in our classrooms and therefore the students do not have to wear masks in class unless otherwise instructed by his/her teacher. If a staff member or student wishes to wear a mask at all times we totally support their decision.**
- 3. Absolutely no guests, parents or guardians are to visit the school without an appointment.** The front doors will be locked. Please call the school office should you need anything and we will be happy to assist you. Should a meeting be required it will take place at an alternate location. **1-306-696-2252**
- 4. Bathroom Breaks-**There will be an adult hall monitor who will escort students to and from their classroom should they need to use the washroom. Proper hygiene will be imperative!!
- 5. Should your child become ill** he/she will be removed from the classroom and placed in a designated area of the school until they can be picked-up.
- 6. Students do not need phones at school.** Should they need to phone home arrangements can be made for them to use the phone. Phones will be confiscated and returned at the end of the day should they be brought to school.

7. **Breakfast and Lunch**-are being provided for the students. We will not be using microwaves so if your child brings any additional food please ensure it does not require the microwave. **“Think Healthy!!!!”**
8. **Inside Shoes/Hats**-all students must have an inside pair of shoes. All outside shoes will come off at the entrance door. As well, all hats are also to be taken off and stored in their designated locker. Everyone’s cooperation is greatly appreciated!!

****This is a new experience for all of us. Please be patient with us as we begin our new school year. Our staff will be taking all the necessary precautions in keeping the children safe. Discussions around procedures, masks and hygiene will be on-going. We are looking forward to seeing the students.**
